Allergic/Anaphylactic Reaction Procedure

- 1. Make PI or Sub-I aware of allergic reaction immediately
- 2. Gradual onset allergic or anaphylactic reaction with mild dermal response and WITHOUT respiratory distress will be treated with Diphenhydramine 25 mg tablet.
- 3. Moderate respiratory distress and dermal response will be treated with Diphenhydramine 50mg/mL 0.5 ml Intramuscular injection and can repeat every 30 minutes as needed.
- 4. A **Severe Anaphylactic** reaction showing signs of severe or significant dermal response and/or respiratory distress will be treated with Epinephrine 1:1000 mg 1.0 ml Intramuscular injection. **911 will be called immediately.**
- 5. All subjects will be assessed by the physician and observed by staff until dismissed by physician and/or symptoms have resolved with discussion of aftercare from physician orders upon exiting.
- 6. Report as directed to sponsor.
